Airway Meadows Golf Course held its 11th Annual Benefit Tournament on Saturday, August 16th. The format was a 4-player scramble. This year's event was to benefit Skyler Castro. Skyler was diagnosed 4/30/14 with Ewing Sarcoma, a rare bone cancer. The tumor started in her psoas muscle which is between her spine and hip. It was 7 cm in that muscle, plus she had a 2 cm tumor on her spine & a couple spots on her lungs. She has had an MRI, Scans, bone scans & PET Scans. She has also gone through surgery, has gotten a 2nd opinion with doctors in Boston who concurred with Albany Med for the treatment plan and she still has 5 weeks of Chemo ahead of her plus surgery to remove the tumor and half her psoas muscle, then radiation therapy & then 12 more weeks of Chemo. She may also need physical therapy. Skyler missed the last two months of school. She also could not play softball which she likes so much. The family is hoping by January 2015 she will be able to return to school. She will need to be tutored the first few weeks of school this fall. Through the generosity of all the participants we were able to raise over \$8,500.
