Lori & Corey Martin Family

On November 6, 2007 Lori Martin, a single mother of three, received the worse news a parent could imagine. Two of her children were in a fatal car accident. Lori's eldest daughter Jessica Canfield, only 16 years of age, was driving when she lost control of the vehicle and hit a tractor trailer head on. She died on impact. Lori's other daughter Corey, was riding in the backseat and was airlifted to Albany Medical Center, where Lori was told she may not live. Corey's seatbelt caused great damage to the girl's small body. Corey's large and small intestines were severely injured and her aorta was torn. Her vertebrae were chattered and the pressure of the seatbelt severed her spinal cord. Lori was told if Corey did live, she would never walk again. While her youngest daughter teetered on the brink of life, Lori was burying her oldest child.

Lori and her family spent one month at Albany Med. in the Intensive Care Unit waiting and hoping that Corey would survive. She lost weight and her condition seemed to deteriorate. Finally, she was discharged to Sunnyview, a rehabilitation center. Corey spent four months trying to relearn simple tasks like seeing and speaking. She was unable to focus her eyes and slurred her speech. She could not walk, run or play. She was bound to a wheelchair and Lori did not leave her side.

Corey has been considered a miracle child. She can walk 20 feet with special braces and continues to improve. So much of the family's life has changed over the past few months to be with her daughter. Prior to the accident she was in nursing school working on a degree to support her family and hopes to one day finish nursing school.
