



2012 Benefit Tournament

Airway Meadows Golf Course held its 9th Annual Benefit Tournament on Sunday, September 9th. 100 players came out to play in the 4-player scramble tournament. This year's event was to benefit Lukas Lemery. Lukas is a four year old boy from Hudson Falls who on July 16th had a severe headache. After 2 MRI's he was found to have a cyst the size of a tennis ball pressing on a tumor nearly the same size. He underwent an operation removing much of the tumor but isn't out of the woods yet as the tumor is intertwined with his optic nerves, pituitary gland (which controls over 20 bodily functions), hypothalamus and brain arteries. Lukas is currently blind in one eye. His parents hope that he keeps his sight in the other. He is already on several medicines to control many bodily functions as well as seizures. The estimated costs for such a surgery and long term post care are in the hundreds of thousands of dollars after insurance. Through the generosity of all the participants we were able to raise over \$7100.
