Taylor was a graduate of Saratoga Springs High School and a defensive lineman on the football team in his junior in senior years. After graduation he joined the Army and died on June 21, 2010 as a result of a suicide bomb attack in Lar Sholtan, a village in Konar province, Northern Afghanistan. He was buried July 28 in Arlington with full military honors and received the Bronze Star Medal and Purple Heart Medal. Of all the things life had to offer Taylor, the most important of all were his friends and family and so Taylor's family hopes to share a legacy of achievement and generosity through The David Taylor Miller Scholarship Fund for a graduating Saratoga Springs High School student. The fund is in the process of being renamed Taylor's Heroes.
